# What does Clinic in the Park Do?

**Increase Access** to health services in public venues (parks, schools, resource centers) & connect to medical and dental homes

## **Sustain & Advocate**

- Provide community resources in underserved communities
- Demonstrate economic benefit for public services
- Advocate for child health policies

**Provide Venue(s)** where health organizations, public, private and academic institutions/organizations and individuals ***collaborate to provide services.***

- One Stop Shop
- Greater impact - refer and cross refer
- Replicable model



# Who are our Collaborators?

Clinic in the Park partners with >50 Collaborators that connect our visitors to services, provide free screenings, and administer health education





# Who are our Visitors?

- Underserved children and families in Orange County
- Residents of Santa Ana, Anaheim, West Costa Mesa and Irvine





# Volunteer Requirements

- Each volunteer must have a waiver signed and submitted on the day of the Clinic. If under 18, a parent or guardian must also sign the waiver
- Each organization must be available to volunteer for the entire Clinic which includes setup and break down
  - Time from 8:30am-2pm\* subject to change



# During the Clinic

- **Dress Code**
  - Wear your organization or school's apparel
  - Dress comfortably but appropriately to work with visitors
- **Transportation**
  - We do not provide transportation
  - We suggest at least one carpool
- **Orientation**
  - We will conduct an orientation at start of each Clinic
  - At the conclusion of orientation, volunteers will be assigned to stations



# Responsibilities

- Be attentive and cheerful (don't be on your phones, etc)
  - Set up and breakdown Clinic
  - Help Collaborators at specific booths
    - (getting families to complete health surveys, handing out produce, helping with BMI measurements, etc)
  - Study brochures- Welcome Table Volunteers especially
  - Assist visitors
    - Let them know what types of services are being offered
- \*We want our volunteers to enjoy the Clinic and get the most out of the experience! Let us know at any time if you want to switch tasks





# Typical Tasks

- Tracking Data
- Needs Assessment Surveys
- Welcome Table Spin-Wheel
- Bicycle Helmet Fitting
- Visitor Engagement and Coordination

- Volunteers can take a short break
- Please notify leaders at station before taking break
