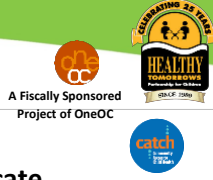

EXAMPLES OF COST SAVINGS:³

\$38/Booster Seat saves **\$2,700** in child safety costs

\$14/Bicycle Helmet saves **\$630** in child safety costs

\$65 in vision screening +/- glasses saves **\$162** in medical costs

An oral screening saves **\$447** over 5 years
