#### **EXAMPLES OF COST SAVINGS:**3

\$38/Booster Seat saves \$2,700 in child safety costs \$14/Bicycle Helmet saves \$630 in child safety costs \$65 in vision screening +/- glasses saves \$162 in medical costs

An oral screening saves \$447 over 5 years
